	Activity	How did your child get on?
Writing for Ladybird class	<p>On the reverse, please look at the picture shown. Can your child think of a sentence and orally rehearse it with you several times before they attempt to write it. We do not expect all words to be spelt correctly, instead, they should be phonetically plausible.</p> <p>If your child is able to do this, please encourage them to write more than one sentence! 😊</p>	
Ant class	<p>As Ant class will be leading their first Collective Worship next week, instead of completing the writing activity above we would like the children to practise their lines attached please (unless you would like to complete the writing as well of course 😊).</p>	
Both classes- Maths	<p>In Maths this week, we have continued exploring numbers. We have been using 'Ten frames' to work out what two numbers can make a whole. E.g we would put 6 dots in the frame with 2 at the top and 4 at the bottom. This would tell us that $2+4=6$. We could also put 3 at the top and 3 at the bottom showing us that $3+3=6$.</p>  <p>This week, we would like the children to look at different numbers that make 10 by completing the activity on the reverse of this sheet.</p>	

Can you write the number sentences to make 10?
