

# Uniform and things you will need...

## Uniform List-

- Trousers in grey, skirts and pinafore dresses in grey or navy
- Sweatshirt or cardigan in navy with the school logo
- Shirts, polo shirts or blouses in pale blue or white
- Summer dresses in blue and white gingham
- Summer shorts/culottes in grey or navy
- Socks and tights in grey, white or navy
- Footwear with a sensible heel: Black shoes, no trainers as everyday wear
- PE kit- Navy blue shorts, white or navy t-shirt with the school logo, plimsolls for indoor and trainers for outdoor PE, plain navy jogging bottoms, and a PE bag with the school logo
- A Book bag is available from Uniform Direct, 333 High Street Lincoln
- Jewellery– A wrist watch and small studded earrings are the only permitted items of jewellery children can wear in school
- Long hair must be tied back for PE
- Children are permitted to wear plain blue or black hair bands or bobbles
- No make-up or nail varnish
- Additional water bottles are available from school

## **Water bottles**

We encourage the children to drink regularly throughout the school day to keep them hydrated. You will be able to purchase a school water bottle for your child from the school office at a cost of £2.50. Your child will bring his/her school water bottle home with them each night. Please ensure that the bottle is washed and re-filled with water for them to bring with them each day. We will refill their bottle for them at school should he/she drink all of their water over the course of the day.

## **Reading book bags**

Children will require a school book bag (rather than a rucksack) as it provides good protection for our books and helps to ensure respect and responsibility for their belongings. They are also just the right size for the children to keep in the book boxes and then they can have independent access to them. These can be purchased from Uniform Direct. The children will need to bring their book bag to school with them every day. There is an expectation that the children read with you at home as part of their homework tasks and their reading book should be in their book bag every day as they will need it for part of their phonics lessons.
