



Welcome to the Globe Guardian challenge.

This morning, in Collective Worship, the children were introduced to the Globe Guardian Challenge. As individuals and as a school community we look for ways to care for the planet and to be agents of positive change.

The Globe Guardian challenge aims to raise awareness, the need to care for the planet and to promote some of the changes and actions we can make to play our part.

Initially, Welton St Mary's pupils (with the help of their families) are being invited to complete the Bronze challenge. Each child will be given a card detailing the tasks they need to complete to become a Bronze Globe Guardian.

The Bronze challenge requires 20 points to be earned. Your child/ren will need to have completed all of the first 15 tasks. The remaining 5 points can be gained by completing 5 further tasks, either repeating one of the 15 tasks (and double ticking it) **or** by thinking of their own 'wild card' activities, which must fall into one of the four categories (detailed below).

Please put your child's name and class as the subject. Siblings can submit evidence on the same email.

We will be posting some of the photographs in the Globe Guardian section of the school website. If you are **not** happy for us to share your photograph(s) please state this in your email.

A special certificate will be awarded each month to the wild card task judged to be the best and will be presented during Friday's Collective Worship. We will be sharing some of the photos during these Collective Worships too.

On completion of the tasks, your child/ren need to return their record card, with the 20 tasks signed off, to their class teacher. They will then be awarded their Bronze certificate and *metal pin badge during a Friday Collective Worship.

To make completion of the tasks more manageable, we suggest you have a go at completing one or two tasks a week. We do not expect anyone to complete the challenge before 19th November. Please do send evidence of your child/ren's tasks as they complete them, especially the wild card ideas.

Notes about litter picking task:
