### HAF 15% discretionary HAF Evoucher Allocations

The local authority continuously monitors and reviews the use and impact of the HAF programme in Lincolnshire. This helps us to support schools and other providers that may require guidance on the most effective way to target their current cohort of disadvantaged children.

HAF vouchers are auto allocated to benefits-related FSM students and if you feel you might qualify you can apply at [Apply for free school meals – Lincolnshire County Council](#)

As a school we use the following characteristics in deciding which students should benefit from the extra 15% E-vouchers, this is additional to the HAF vouchers that are allocated to benefits-related FSM and are students who are not in receipt of benefits-related FSM but who the school believe could benefit from HAF.

We consider the following characteristics in order:

- Children being supported by targeted services (child in need, child protection or TAC)
- Children with special educational needs and/or disabilities
- Young carers
- Children in care
- Children being supported by targeted Pastoral support (Attendance / Early Help)
- Ukrainian and Afghanistan refugees
