The before school, after school and holiday sessions will provide a range of stimulating and creative activities in a safe, secure and fun environment, providing an outstanding service for busy parents.

Our Calendar...

The before and after school care will be available every day the school is open.

Our Staff...

Parents can have peace of mind knowing their children are in safe hands. All staff are fully trained in safeguarding and paediatric first aid, and are all DBS checked. They are also qualified and experienced in working with children in primary school environments. We call them Activity Professionals because we believe that this truly reflects the nature of their role and the dedicated approach they have to ensuring that your child learns, has fun, and is safe and well looked after.

Admissions...

Only children attending Welton St Marys Academy are eligible to attend the before school and after school.

All places are subject to availability. The wrap around care provision is limited to 40 spaces on a first come, first served basis, which can be booked online up until 30 minutes prior to the session starting. Our staff will ensure all children are at their required classroom for the start of the school day. Reception children will be supervised to their classroom before school and collected from their classroom after school.

All staff will be made aware of the details of any new child attending the session. Children's attendance will be recorded in a register, with an adult being required to physically sign them in for the morning session and sign them out for the evening session.

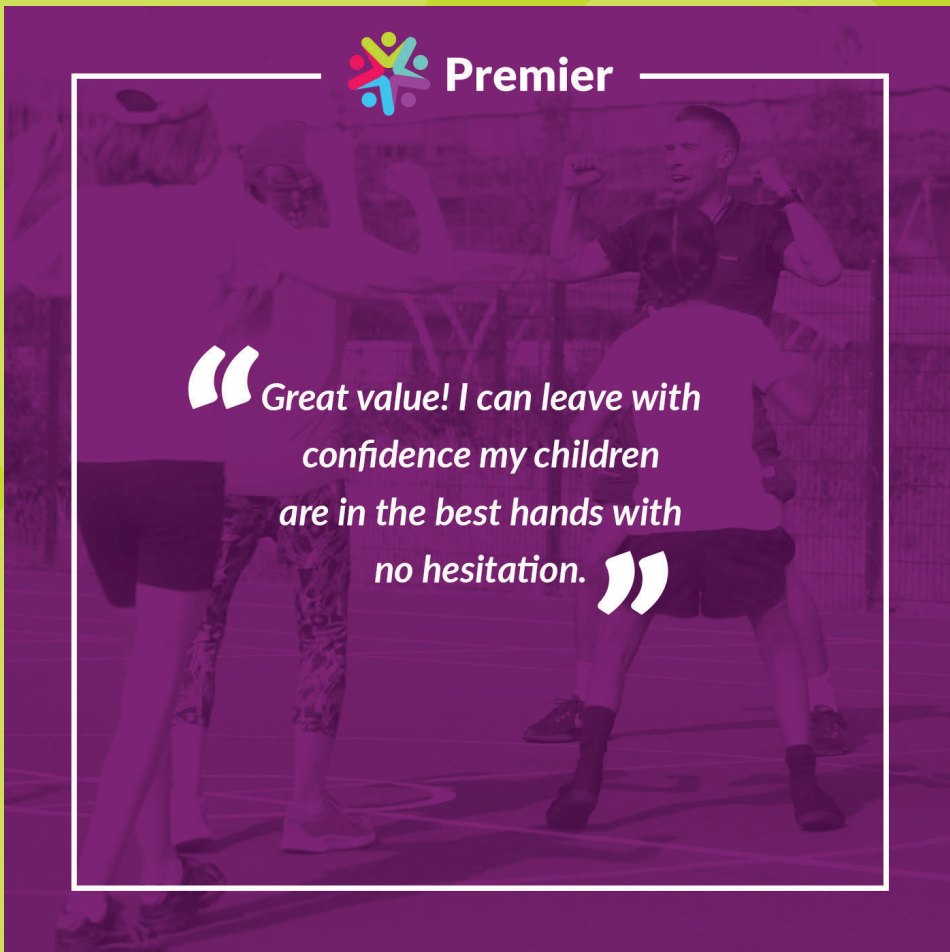

Session Details...

Before School Club:

Time: 7.30 am - 8.50 am Year Groups: Reception - Year 6

Price: £5.25 per session



Give your child a great start to the day!

Evidence shows that introducing elements of physical activity and play to children before school starts can engage their minds and prepare them for the day ahead.

The morning sessions will run for 80 minutes and aim to stimulate the learning experiences of your child.

Children who attend will enter school alert and ready for the day, having engaged their minds and body whilst learning a host of valuable skills including:

- The importance of being punctual and well prepared for the day
- Being more alert for a day of learning within the school
- Understanding the importance of a healthy lifestyle
- Improved coordination, balance, agility and flexibility
- Appropriate and effective communication with others
- Engaging and interacting appropriately with other children
- Being given realistic challenges to achieve
- Using tactics and strategies to increase chances of success

Breakfast brain power...

We believe that it is important that children start the day with a good breakfast. Each day children will be served foods that are rich in grains, fibre and protein and low in added sugar to help boost attention span, concentration and memory.

Children will enjoy sitting down with their friends to enjoy a diverse menu of healthy breakfast options.

Staff are seated with the children during meal times to encourage a "family" type atmosphere. At least one member of staff holds a current Basic Food Hygiene certificate and all food and drink complies with dietary and religious requirements.



Timings...

Before school club price: £5.25

After school club: 3.30pm – 5pm is £5.50

After school club: 3.30pm – 6pm is £9.00

Signing in & out...

In the morning, parents must accompany their child to the door of the hall where a member of staff will greet them and ask them to sign the register, indicating that they have handed their child into our care.

The process for signing children out from the club is the same as signing in with parents and carers collecting from the Kids club entrance of the hall. Parents are welcome to collect children at any time between 3.30pm and 6.00pm.

After School 'Play Active' Club...

Time: 3.30 pm - 6.00 pm

Year Groups: Reception - Year 6

The after-school club reflects how important the school consider a healthy lifestyle to be, and therefore the activities are set up to engage the children's mind, body and soul.

The club will provide a relaxed environment to support children's learning and individual interests. Activities will be designed to be engaging and challenging for the ages and abilities of each child.

There will be a range of indoor and outdoor activities daily as well as a quiet area where children can relax and do some homework reading if they wish. Children will be encouraged to take part in physical activity each day to help them stay fit, but also have some down time in quieter activities with friends to recharge their batteries.

The fun, physical activities are designed to appeal to every child – not just sporty children. Our Play Active sessions encourage fun-based physical activities, rather than traditional sports. The aim is to encourage children to get physically active through play, placing emphasis on inclusion rather than specific sports skills and techniques. This, in turn, improves social skills, self-esteem, balance, coordination and physical wellbeing.

In addition, children will develop a wide variety of skills that they can use beyond the sports field, including

- Celebrating perseverance and acknowledging achievement
- Engaging and interacting appropriately with other children
- Setting achievable personal goals to reach
- Improving self-esteem and the confidence to try new things
- The ability to follow rules and respect themselves and others
- Understanding the importance of a healthy lifestyle
- Improving control, coordination, balance, agility and flexibility
- Communicating appropriately and effectively with others

Children will have a wide range of activities to keep them occupied each day such as capture the flag, parachute games, archery, dodgeball, quiet reading, watching cartoons, playing board games or completing jigsaw puzzles. Once a week we will also add specialist activities such as dance, yoga or cooking.



Planned Activities...

The after school club is an extension of the school day. With this in mind, it has been designed to run smoothly, whilst reflecting the school's outstanding quality

Our staff are trained to adapt each day based on particular children's needs or the weather. However, the structure and timing for each day will be consistent.

The below table shows an example of what the main planned activities each day could look like. Activities will be designed to fit in with the schools termly theme, to compliment classroom activities.

Monday	Arts & Crafts Children get to be creative and improve their coordination whilst colouring, drawing and cutting. Activities include: finger painting, origami, making paper chains, hat making and colouring in.
Tuesday	Music, Dance & Drama See your child grow in confidence through engaging, accessible activities! This incorporates anything from street dance and cheerleading to acting and musical theatre.
Wednesday	Sport & Games Children get to develop their communication and leadership skills through team games. They'll be able to try sports and activities they may not have tried before. Sports include tug of war, fencing, archery and yoga, to name a few.
Thursday	Cooking & Technology Children can help prepare their healthy snack while learning about the importance of a healthy diet. Our practical Fun-Trition lessons will allow the children to have a hands-on experience. Activities include 'the digestions race' and making fruit pizzas!
Friday	Fun Activities Friday fun day! A great way to end a productive week. Includes parachute games, giant Jenga, nerf play, laser tag and more.

Signing in & out...

When collecting their child, parents must come to the hall door where a member of staff will meet them and check their ID if necessary.

Parents must sign the register to confirm that they have taken their child from our care. This is an important safeguarding procedure and must be adhered to at all times.

If a friend, relative, family member or neighbour is collecting their child, the parent will have to inform us in the morning session, via email or with a phone call. Each child will have a collection password, which will need to be quoted on collection.

Behaviour...

Whilst attending breakfast club or the after school club children are expected to:

- Follow the school values.
- Use socially acceptable behaviour.
- Respect one another, accepting differences of race, gender, ability, age and religion.
- Choose and participate in a variety of activities.
- Ask for help if needed.
- Enjoy their time at the club.

Positive behaviour is encouraged by:

- Staff acting as positive role models.
- Praising appropriate behaviour.
- Sticker rewards.
- Informing parents about individual achievements.
- Weekly awards given out during Friday's whole school assembly for exceptional accomplishments

Dealing with inappropriate behaviour:

Challenging behaviour will be addressed in a calm, firm and positive manner. In the first instance, the child will be given the opportunity to reflect on their behaviour and make the correct decision on how to behave moving forward. If a child doesn't choose to improve their behaviour it may be necessary for a child to be temporarily removed from the activity. Staff will explain why the behaviour displayed is deemed inappropriate. Staff will encourage and facilitate mediation between children to try to resolve conflicts through discussion and negotiation. Staff will consult with parents to formulate clear strategies for dealing with persistent inappropriate behaviour.

If, after consultation with parents and the implementation of behaviour management strategies, a child continues to display inappropriate behaviour, the breakfast club or after school club may decide to exclude the child. The reasons and processes involved will be clearly explained to the child and their parent/carer. All behaviour issues will be recorded.



First Aid...

All incidents are dealt with by a qualified first aider and will be recorded in the wrap around care accident book.

Incidents will be accurately reported to the parents/carer upon collection and signed by a member of either breakfast or after school club staff.

Accident records will give details of time, date and nature of the accident, details of the child involved, type and location of the injury, action taken, and by whom.

Parents of any child who becomes unwell during either breakfast club or after school club will be contacted immediately. If a child is sent home during school hours, the after school club will be informed of their absence by a member of the school admin/office staff.

Missing or Uncollected children...

In the unlikely event that a child goes missing, the following procedure will be undertaken:

1. Senior school staff will be informed of the missing child.
2. Breakfast club & afterschool supervisors will search the inside of the building and delegate an outside search of the building to another member of staff.
3. If the child remains missing, the emergency services and parents/guardians will be contacted.





For Parents: Booking your child's place...

You must have pre-booked your child into the session online. Any child not pre- booked is not be covered by our insurance and will not be allowed into the session. There are a limited number of spaces available for each session and these are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

How to book online

1. The simplest way to book your child onto any of the Premier Education Group Activities is to visit; www.premier-education.com
2. Click on 'Book a course'.
3. In the 'Location' box type in Welton St Marys Academy and click "search".
4. Click on "view venue" when you see Welton St Marys Academy in the search results.
5. Select the activity you would like to book (before school, after school or holiday session) and click "book now"
6. Register your details or log in if you are a returning customer.
7. Follow booking and payment process through to complete your booking (to pay with Childcare Vouchers tick the relevant box in the Extras section).
8. You will receive a booking confirmation email (if paying with Childcare Vouchers this email confirms how much you should instruct your scheme provider to pay.

Online payments are subject to a 49p processing fee

Last minute bookings:

We understand that plans change, often at short notice, and we will try to be flexible to accommodate most situations.

You may book your child into any session online right up until 30 minutes prior the start of the session, subject to a place being available.

Flexi booking...

In addition to our booking terms and conditions all bookings confirmed by us are final and non-refundable. However, if you chose to pay for flexi booking costing an additional £3.50, you are able to alter your booking at any time up to the start time of the activity.

Childcare Voucher Providers...

We are registered to accept payments from a number of childcare providers.

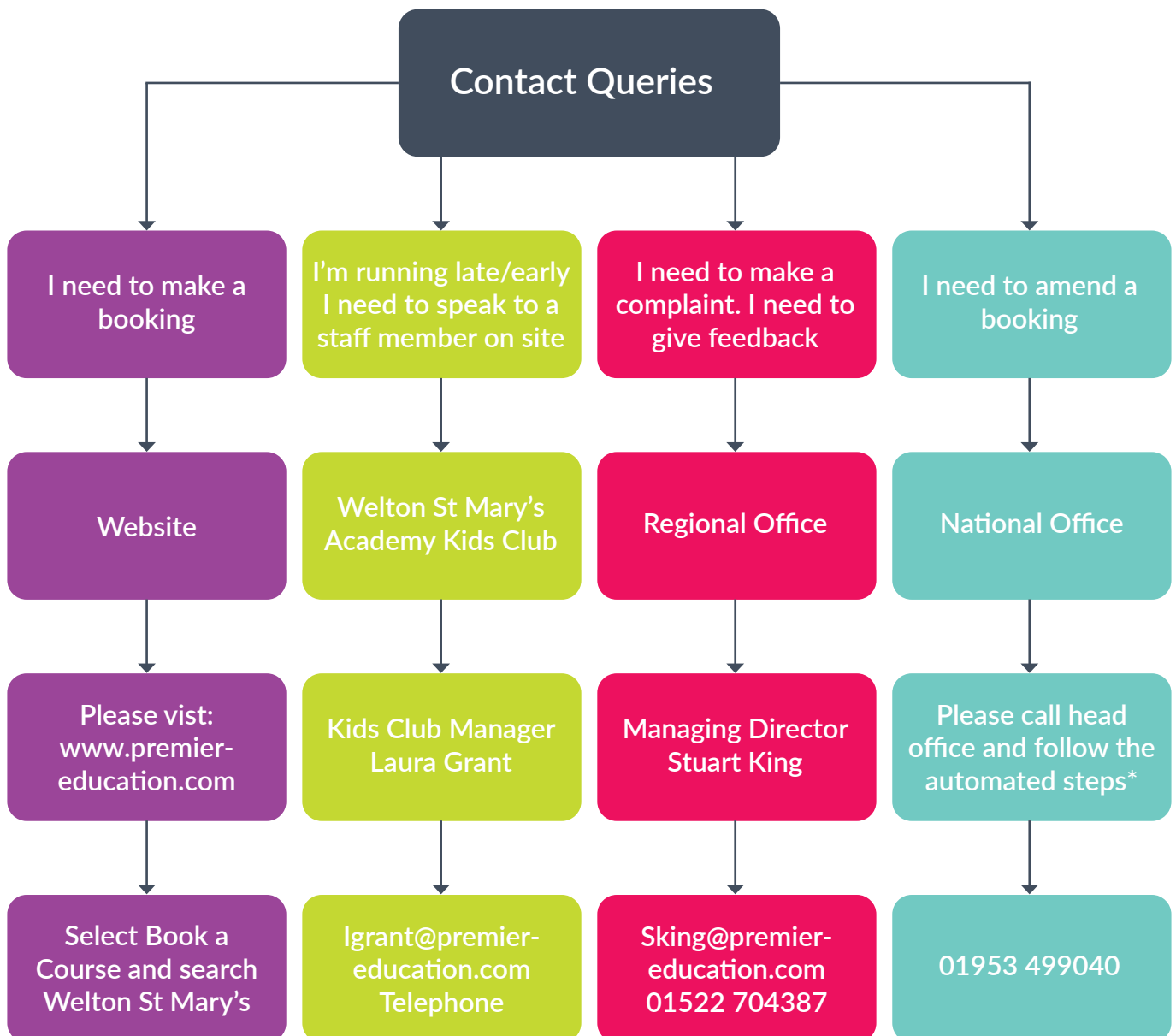
